GETTING HERE

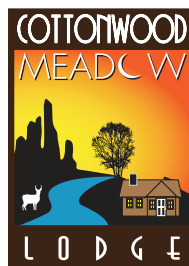
We are in the heart of Bryce Canyon country between Hatch and Panguitch about 4 hours north of Las Vegas or 4 hours south of Salt Lake City, on Highway 89 between Mile Marker 122 and 123.

We sit at an elevation of 6,800 feet just 25 minutes below the entrance to Bryce Canyon National Park, a close drive to the North entrance to Zion National Park, Capitol Reef National Park, Cedar Breaks National Monument, Kodachrome Basin State Park, and only 2 hours from the North Rim of the Grand Canyon.

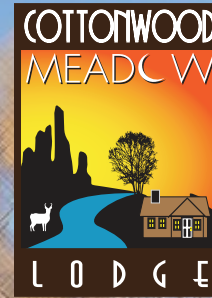

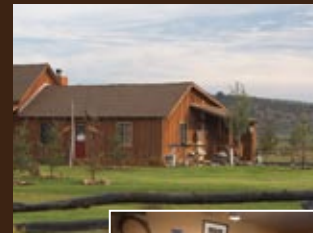
The "Chef's Kitchen" in THE FARMHOUSE features Viking Range and new appliances with a view overlooking our private two acre pond.
